The policy includes requirements relating to the following:

- Purchase of sustainable cleaning and hard floor and carpet care products meeting the sustainability criteria outlined in IEQ Credit 3.3. (The project team is not required to apply for IEQc3.3, but the Green Cleaning Policy must adhere to the requirements of the credit.)
- Purchase of cleaning equipment meeting the sustainability criteria outlined in IEQ Credit 3.4. (The project team is not required to apply for IEQc3.4, but the Green Cleaning Policy must adhere to the requirements of the credit.)
- Establishment of standard operating procedures (SOPs) addressing how an effective cleaning and hard floor and carpet maintenance system will be consistently utilized, managed and audited. If applicable, it specifically addresses cleaning to protect vulnerable building occupants.
- Development of strategies for promoting and improving hand hygiene, including both hand washing and the use of alcohol-based waterless hand sanitizers.
- Development of guidelines addressing the safe handling and storage of cleaning chemicals used in the building, including a plan for managing hazardous spills or mishandling incidents.
- Development of requirements for staffing and training of maintenance personnel appropriate to the needs of the building. It addresses the training of maintenance personnel in the hazards of use, disposal and recycling of cleaning chemicals, dispensing equipment and packaging.
