The [REDACTED] office renovation recycles and collects all paper, plastic, cardboard, glass, and metals. All commercial properties in New York City are required to establish a recycling program under the guidelines of New York City Local Law 87 of 1992. This law requires separation of certain grades of paper (high-grade white paper, newspapers, magazines, catalogs, and phone books) and encourages recovery of all other mixed paper grades. All businesses are also required to separate cardboard boxes, and food and beverage establishments must separate glass, metal, and plastic for recycling.
